Last winter, SOS Third World intervened to assist the victims of a powerful rainstorm that occurred in the city of N'Djamena, the capital of Chad. The floodwaters, reaching over a meter in depth, caused the destruction of all food reserves. In these critical circumstances, flour, millet, pulses, and vegetables are often the only source of sustenance, and many people struggle to recover what has been lost due to a lack of financial means.

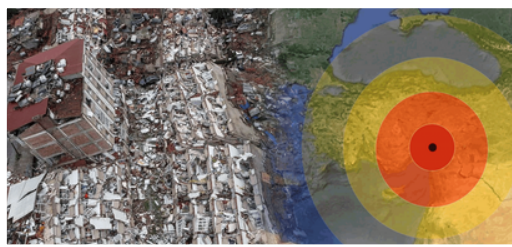
To provide immediate assistance, **food items, mattresses, and mats were purchased.** Our collaborators worked diligently to provide food and essential goods to those severely affected by the floods.
